

Ramsey Rural Museum and Ramsey 1940's Ramsey Fen Fair 19th May 2019

The Ramsey Rural Museum and the Ramsey 1940's will be holding a joint event on 19th May 2019. It will take the form of a giant village fair and will be open to the public from 11.00 am. There will be music and dancing at the 1940's Camp on the previous evening (Saturday 18th May). There will be provision for overnight camping on the Saturday evening. Entry to the Sunday event for adults will be £2.00 whilst accompanied children (under 16) will be FREE.

There will be a food area, a trader's market place with marquees, static vehicle displays, a fun dog show, various games, clay pigeon shooting, fairground amusements and activities.

Stalls (6ft tables in marquees) and pitches for vans or your own gazebo will be available for traders, food vendors and for groups to promote themselves or run games or activities. These stalls and pitches will be free to charities or those who can show that they are working on behalf of a charity. For commercial traders or organisations raising money for themselves by sales or games a stall will cost £15.00 and a pitch will be £20.00.

We aim to make this a truly community event with opportunities for local organisations and clubs to take part. Based on a footfall of approximately 1700 at a similar event in 2018 we would expect a good attendance.

Any profits will be used to support the activities of the Ramsey Rural museum and the Ramsey 1940's camp.

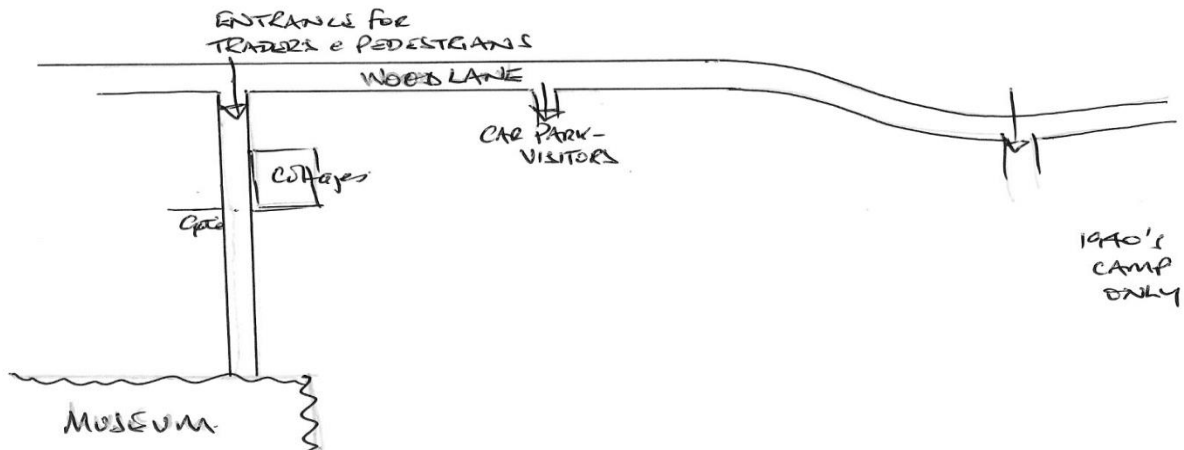
Power can be supplied to a limited number of food vendors (first come first served).

Marshalls will be on site from 8.00am to allocate stalls/pitches and allow for set up. There will be a co-ordinators tent in the centre of the field to assist.

Vehicles must be parked in the area provided after set up unless they can be parked within the area of the pitch.
